

# DESIGN DISPATCH

Todd Merrill Studio has opened a permanent three-room salon at Bergdorf Goodman, within the seventh floor decorative arts section. The space will host quarterly installations to showcase works by the gallery's international roster of nearly 50 artists and designers, with an emphasis on handmade contemporary craft and collectible design. Encompassing roughly 600 square feet, the rotating space—currently defined by sisal rugs and Phillip Jeffries' Max's Metallic Raffia wallpaper in gold—follows years of pop-ups by the contemporary design gallery within the department store.

The inaugural installation highlights a range of artists working across various materials—with resin pieces by Draga & Aurel, Djivan Schapira, and Creators of Objects forming a central theme. Additional presentations include Kiki Goti's Murano-made "Muses" series of mirrors and sconces produced with Vetrulia, Rose Hartman's photography, [Christopher Russell's Chinoiserie-inspired ceramic vessels](#), and Maarten Vrolijk's Sakura Glass Vessels. The exhibition also introduces ceramicist Paige Stewart, whose sculptural Legacy Totem reflects her practice's layered, wheel-thrown forms.
